

Sponsorship with the NCA

I have EU Settled or Pre-Settled Status

You have right to work in the UK

I have Spouse/Dependant / Family visa

You have temporary right to work in the UK

I do not hold a visa or have another visa type

Check if you need a visa to work in the UK (and what type):

I have a Student visa

You have temporary right to work in the UK up to 20 hours per week
* Can be up to full time during holidays

I have a Graduate visa

You have temporary right to work in the UK

I have a Skilled Worker visa

You have temporary right to work in the UK but this cannot be transferred to another employer

Sponsorship Requests

All requests are not guaranteed and must be assessed on an individual basis once an offer of employment has been made and are subject to conditions and eligibility set at the time of the request by UKVI.

If you start employment with us on a different visa type, switching to sponsorship at a later date is not guaranteed.

If you are already in the UK on a Skilled Worker visa with another employer, new sponsorship with the NCA would be required.

If you are working for the NCA on a Skilled Worker visa, we will need to assess if any change of roles requires new sponsorship.



If you gain an offer of employment from the NCA and you are a non-UK or ROI citizen, your right to work must be verified with UKVI with a share code.
